Your nomination should include a cover letter and one-page summary of the nominee's achievements, including:

- Evidence of quality of leadership and organizational ability in fundraising campaigns.
Description of outstanding achievements and personal philanthropic commitment.
Description of fundraising goals achieved through his/her leadership and efforts.
Evidence of success in recruiting, motivating and mentoring others.
Description of participation in and support for other nonprofit organizations.

Supporting documents may be included and should enhance narrative and not be used instead of the narrative to answer the criteria. No more than 3 pages of supporting documents are allowed.
