DEADLINE: MARCH 17, 2014

This award recognizes an individual with exceptional skills in coordinating and motivating others for fundraising projects to benefit charitable institutions. The nominee must have demonstrated exceptional leadership skills in coordinating fundraising projects for more than one nonprofit organization in the past year, or several years.

Your nomination should include a cover letter and one-page summary of the nominee’s achievements, including:

- Evidence of quality of leadership and organizational ability in fundraising campaigns.
- Description of time, effort and personal financial commitment.
- Description of fundraising goals achieved by his/her efforts.
- Evidence of success in recruiting and motivating others.
- Description of participation in other nonprofit organizations.

Supporting documents may be included and should enhance narrative and not be used instead of the narrative to answer the criteria. No more than 3 pages of supporting documents are allowed.
