Your nomination should include a cover letter and one-page summary of the nominee's achievements, including:

- Description of what the nominee(s) did, what other people were involved in the process, the time, talent and/or treasure the youth gave and the results that were achieved.
Description of the impact the nominee had on the community. (Please include names and contact numbers for the organization(s) that benefited from the nominee's work).
Description of the long term impact of the nominee's work.

Supporting documents may be included and should enhance narrative and not be used instead of the narrative to answer the criteria. No more than 3 pages of supporting documents are allowed.
